- Managing the negative PA
- Repairing quarter cracks and how to shoe the foot
- Puncture wounds: Fabricating a therapeutic shoe, therapeutic approach and follow up
- Laminitis: Damage assessment, venogram & treatment options for the acute & chronic case.
